COMMENT

Using drones of various types to attack civilians is the kind of crime that the Armed Forces of Ukraine (AFU) commit deliberately, cynically and with full understanding of the consequences of their actions. With UAV vision systems supplied by Western sponsors drone operators perfectly identify the victim. They see that there is a child, an elderly person or a woman in their crosshairs.

Since the beginning of 2024, Ukrainian UAVs have wounded no less than 656 civilians and killed more than a hundred (114)¹.

In July alone, 186 civilians became victims of the Kiev regime's drones: 170 were injured, 16 - killed. The majority of civilians injured or killed by Ukrainian UAVs were registered in the Belgorod Region - 79 people, six of them died of their wounds. In the DPR, 48 civilians became victims of AFU drone attacks, five of them were killed. In the Kursk Region, at least 29 civilians were subject to the same sort of Kiev regime's criminal activity, one person died as the result of a UAV strike.

The Ukrainian butchers use UAVs to target civilians in residential areas, track down and burn civilian cars, attack firefighters extinguishing fires, medics and ambulances, civilian infrastructure repair crews, farming machines working in grain fields.

Ukrainian drone operators do not spare even children. Since January 1, no less than 43 minors have suffered from targeted drops of explosive objects by drones in eleven Russian regions adjacent to the frontline. At least nine children have been killed, 34 – injured by AFU UAVs.

Among the most cynical crimes of the Kiev executioners is an aimed drop of ammunition on a playground surrounded by multistorey residential buildings in the town of Shebekino, Belgorod Region, on July 11. As a result, five children were hospitalized with mine blast injuries of varying severity. The youngest boy had to undergo a complex surgery on his spine. Doctors fought for the life of the eldest one for more than a week, but the 16-year-old could not be saved. The teenager died of his wounds.



A TRUCK DRIVER KILLED, HIS WOUNDED PASSENGER FINISHED OFF WITH A DRONE IN THE VILLAGE OF BABINO, KHERSON REGION

On April 4, in the village of Babino, Ukrainian drones attacked a GAZelle truck that was delivering water and food to a local store. The driver and his passenger were killed. The strike was carried out in the daytime. The UAV operator saw clearly that the truck had no military purpose and was carrying out a socially significant function.

The passenger survived the first attack. He managed to crawl aside and apply a tourniquet on his wounded leg. He was killed in cold blood with the second drone that circled over the attack scene.

Later the Ukrainian terrorists used another UAV to attack the civilians from a neighboring village who came to help.










UKRAINIAN UAV ATTACK ON A REPAIR CREW AND AN AMBULANCE IN NOVAYA KAKHOVKA, KHERSON REGION: TWO ELECTRICIANS KILLED

On the same day, April 4, a repair crew busy fixing a cell tower that had been damaged by shelling was attacked by a Ukrainian drone in Novaya Kakhovka.

One of the electricians died on the spot, two others were severily wounded. An ambulance that arrived to help was also attacked by Ukrainian UAVs. The medics avoided damage by sheer miracle. They managed to make to the apartment entrance and bring the wounded inside.

While the Nazi drones prevented their victims from leaving the hideout, one of the wounded, a young electrician, died. The crew's foreman was the only one who survived. He was hospitalized in severe condition.



FATHER AND HIS TWO DAUGHTERS BURNED TO DEATH IN A FAMILY CAR AS A RESULT OF AN ATTACK OF A UKRAINIAN DRONE IN THE VILLAGE OF APANOSVKA, KURSK REGION

On April 10, a Ukrainian drone attacked a civil vehicle by dropping an explosive device on it in the village of Apanasovka of the Kursk Region.

At the time of the attack, a man and his two daughters were in the car. The two schoolgirls, Margarita and Ekaterina, were diligent pupils. The elder sister attended a fine arts club. She was good at painting.



FIREFIGHTERS IN THE CROSSHAIRS: IN TWO DAYS IN GORLOVKA 12 FIREFIGHTERS WOUNDED, TWO FIRE TRUCKS DAMAGED, ONE OF THEM BURNED DOWN COMPLETELY

On April 12, a private house in the Nikitovsky district of Gorlovka was set on fire by an explosive object intentionally dropped on it from a drone. While a fire brigade was extinguishing the fire, they were attacked by another Ukrainian UAV. As a result, 10 employees of the Russian Ministry for Emergencies received injuries of varying severity and had to be hospitalized.

The next day, April 13, the outrageous story happened again. While the fire fighters were trying to prevent a residential house that had been set on fire by a drone from burning down, another UAV attacked them. This time two of the fire brigade were wounded. One fire truck was completely destroyed, the other – damaged.








GAS-TANK TRUCK DRIVER BURNED ALIVE AS THE RESULT OF AN AFU UAV STRIKE

On April 15, in Gorlovka, a Ukrainian UAV carried out an aimed drop of an ammunition directly into the cabin of a gas-tank truck at the territory of a civil gas station.

The truck's driver -a man, born in 1964, employee of the Republican Fuel Company - burned to death.





FOUR WOMEN KILLED AS THE RESULT OF AN AIMED AMMUNITION DROP ON A CIVIL VEHICLE FROM A UAV

On April 23, in the settlement of Mirnoye in the Zaporozhye Region, a Ukrainian drone executed an aimed drop of an ammunition on a civil vehicle that was moving along the road in the vicinity of the settlement of Mirnoye. As the result of the strike, the car roof was ripped apart. All four women who were travelling in the vehicle were killed.



UAV ATTACK ON A SHUTTLE BUS IN THE BRYANSK REGION: A WOMAN DIES OF THE WOUNDS RECEIVED, 3 OTHER CIVILIANS INJURED, INCLUDING A CHILD

On April 25, the AFU used an explosive-laden drone to attack a bus carrying civilians traveling from Starodub to the village of Kurkovichi. Four civilians, including a 14-year-old boy, were injured in the explosion.

Later one of the wounded women died in the hospital.



MASSIVE UAV RAID ON THE VILLAGE OF VOZNESENOVKA, BELGOROD REGION: ONE PERSON IN A COMA, 9 WOUNDED, INCLUDING A TEENAGE GIRL, A FARMING MACHINE DAMAGED


On April 27, several Ukrainian drones attacked the village of Voznesenovka in the Shebekino City District.

One of them dropped an ammunition on a tractor parked on the territory of an agricultural enterprise. A mechanic was injured by the explosion. The 55-year-old man with penetrating shrapnel wounds to his abdomen and a penetrating wound to his eye was taken to the regional clinical hospital.

Another UAV attacked a moving grain truck. As the result of the explosion, the tanker of the grain truck was damaged.

Two FPV drones struck a civilian KAMAZ truck and a passenger car on the highway.

Another kamikaze drone exploded on the asphalt damaging more civilian vehicles – four cars and three trucks. Eight civilians were injured, including a 17-year-old teenage girl. She sustained shrapnel wounds to her back and left arm. A 50-year-old man with a shrapnel wound to his head fell into a coma.




STRIKE DRONE ATTACK ON AGRICULTURAL COMPANY EMPLOYEES ON THEIR WAY TO WORK: 9 DEAD, 41 WOUNDED


In early May, in the morning, three Ukrainian strike drones attacked civilian vehicles near the village of Beryozovka in the Borisovka District, Belgorod Region. They targeted two GAZelle vans, transporting pig farm employees of the Agro-Belogorye group of companies, and a civilian car that was driving nearby. At least three explosive objects were deliberately dropped on them.

As the result, seven workers of the agricultural companies were killed on the spot and 43 people received wounds of varying severity. Two of them died later in the hospital.

In addition, several civilians were injured in the car driving behind the van. Three underage brothers were taken to Childrens' Regional Hospital: 6-year-old Kirill and 17-year-old Denis with concussion, 9-year-old Dima with head injury.







UAV ATTACKS ON FIREFIGHTERS IN THE LINE OF DUTY: SERIAL CRIME

On May 13, a drone attacked a fire truck of the Ministry for Emergencies on its way to a fire scene. As the result of the explosion, four firefighters were injured and had to be hospitalized.

Attacks on firefighters at work are by no means rare. From January to August 2024, a total of at least 71 Ministry of Emergencies' rescuers have suffered at the hands of the AFU as a result of UAV drops, shelling and mitigation of their consequences. Of these, more than a half (55%) were deliberately injured by Ukrainian drones.

UAVs are widely used by the AFU to attack rescue teams. Such cases are registered in the DPR, the LPR, Belgorod, Kherson, Kursk, and Zaporozhye regions, in the Krasnodarsky Krai.

As of August 1, we have collected and verified information on 19 such episodes (21 "drops") since the beginning of the year. If an attack of AFU drones was not "successful", i.e. there were no wounded or killed among firefighters and no damage was done to the fire trucks and other equipment, the incident is recorded only in the most heinous cases, such as several consecutive drone strikes at fire brigades, especially large area of fire, etc.

Speaking about the AFU UAVs in particular, no less than 39 rescuers have been injured by them in the line of duty during the first seven months of the year. At least 12 units of special equipment have been damaged, of which 10 are fire trucks (water tankers). No less than eight "raids" were carried out, at least six firefighters were injured as a result, three fire trucks and one cargo vehicle belonging to the rescuers were hit by Ukrainian drones in July only.

In 13 cases out of the above-mentioned 19, AFU UAV operators hit firefighters while they were extinguishing the fire or prevented them from getting down to work. What makes the situation particularly cynical is the fact that in at least 10 of these cases the fire itself was also caused by the dropping of an explosive object from a Ukrainian drone on private cars, civilian infrastructure facilities and residential houses.



Out of this number, a total of 6 single family houses were set on fire by Ukrainian UAV operators only to strike again when a fire brigade arrived: in the Zaporozhye Region on July 12 and 18, in the Kursk Region on July 16 and May 14, in the DPR on April 12 and 13. On top of that, the same is true for a four-storey residential building in Gorlovka, attacked on May 22.





UAV STRIKES AN AMBULANCE IN TAVRIYSK, KHERSON REGION

An incident that happened in early June in the town of Tavriysk, Kherson Region, continued the series of deliberate attacks on employees and vehicles of the Russian emergency services.

On June 3, in the morning, a Ukrainian drone relentlessly pursued an ambulance. The driver, seeing the UAV, tried to get away from it. Despite the driver's maneuvers, the Ukrainian drone caught up with the medical team and dropped an ammunition.

As a result of the explosion, the driver of the medical vehicle was injured. The ambulance burned down completely.



MURDER OF A JOURNALIST: NIKITA TSITSAGI


On June 16, photojournalist Nikita Tsitsagi from the News.ru news portal was killed while performing his professional duty in the vicinity of Nikolsky Monastery near Ugledar, preparing his photo report. The Ukrainian UAV operators have once again proved their murderous reputation.

Due to their reconnaissance capabilities, they managed to detect a Russian camera crew and delivered an aimed strike with a drone. The video control features of such equipment allow its operators to accurately determine the nature of the target.

According to his colleagues, Nikita Tsitsagi was a fearless cheerful person and a true professional. Even during shellings he was cracking jokes and kept trying to come out of hiding in order to film the aftermath of the incoming attacks and then deliver the real truth about the criminal offences of Ukrainian neo-Nazis who target peaceful villages and their inhabitants.



Nikita Tsitsagi became another victim of V. Zelensky's butchers.



ATTACK ON A NUCLEAR SECURITY FACILITY

On June 25, a UAV hit one of the radiation monitoring posts of the Zaporozhye nuclear power plant located in the village of Velikaya Znamenka. The venue was used for measuring the radiation level of the environment.

As the result of the strike, the facility was completely disabled.



A UAV ATTACK KILLS FIVE: MOTHER, FATHER, THEIR TWO YOUNG CHILDREN AND A NEIGHBOR TRYING TO SAVE THEM FROM THE DRONES

Five people, including two children and their parents, died in the village of Gorodishe of the Rylsk City District of the Kursk Region in an attack of Ukrainian UAVs equipped with night vision cameras.

At about 2 a.m., on June 29, Ukrainian UAVs attacked a single family house and an adjacent piece of land. The drones carried out five aimed drops of ammunition. As the result, five people, including two young children, died. Two more civilians were severely injured.

Georgiy, born in 1973, and Manush, born in 1985, moved to the Kursk Region eight years ago from Armenia, acquired citizenship, bought a small village house with a vegetable garden, worked at a mineral water factory in the neighboring village of Kozino.

The couple had to children: a 2,5-year-old girl Sirusho and a 4-year-old boy Leo.

Georgiy and Manush tried to find shelter from the air attack in the house of their neighbors. Ilya, the neighbors' son, went out to let them in. As the 22-year-old young man approached the gates, there was one more explosion.

The only survivors are Ilya's parents. They were hospitalized in severe condition with traumatic brain injuries and shrapnel wounds to their arms and legs at the Kursk Regional Multidisciplinary Clinical Hospital.



AFU UAVS KILL A 4-YEAR-OLD GIRL, INJURE AT LEAST SEVEN IN ONE DAY IN THE BELGOROD REGION


On June 30, a moving passenger car was attacked by an FPV drone in the vicinity of the Novoye village of the Volokonovka District. In the vehicle there was a family of five: grandmother, grandfather, parents and their child. The girl, 4-year-old Emilia, was mortally wounded in the attack.

Everyone in the car sustained multiple shrapnel wounds. The grandfather of the killed child was hospitalized in severe condition. The man had a penetrating wound of the abdomen.

On the same day, a drone dropped an explosive device on a car parked near multistorey residential buildings in the town of Graivoron. Its driver received a head injury and shrapnel wounds to her leg. Windows were blown out in three apartments in the nearby block of flats. One car was burned down, the driver's side of another car was charred.

All in all, Ukrainian drones injured at least seven civilians in the Belgorod Region on June 30 – two more civilians, a man and a woman, were wounded in a UAV attack on a single family house in the village of Bogun-Gorodok of the Borisovka District.

That week no less than 20 civilians were wounded in the Belgorod Region in the AFU UAV attacks only.



ELECTRICITY SUBSTATIONS PROVIDING POWER TO ENERGODAR AND THE ZAPOROZHYE NUCLEAR POWER PLANT UNDER ATTACK

The AFU attacks on key infrastructure facilities of the Zaporozhye nuclear power plant (ZNPP) have become systematic.

Thus, on July 3, disregarding IAEA safety recommendations and standards, Ukrainian UAVs attacked one of the ZNPP power infrastructure facilities – the Raduga (Rainbow) substation in the city of Energodar.

Nine substation employees were injured in the attack. Two transformers were disabled, disrupting the city's power and water supply. At least 5,000 residents were left without light and water. Two days later, UAVs damaged a power transmission line, once again leaving 7,000 residents of Energodar without electricity.

Earlier, on June 19, as the result of an AFU attack, one of the city's two substations, Luch (Ray), was destroyed. The next day after the attack on the Luch substation, the AFU shelled the site with cluster munitions in order to prevent repair works. Two employees of the Tavria-Energo energy company were injured. The Luch substation was damaged beyond repair.

On June 21, the above-mentioned Raduga substation was also partially damaged.

In total, from June 10 to June 16, at least 112 Ukrainian UAVs flying in the direction of the ZNPP and Energodar were jammed.

At the time of the strike, on July 3, UAV operators were well aware that the Raduga substation remained the only operational one in the area.



FOUR CIVILIANS, INCLUDING A MOTHER AND HER 12-YEAR-OLD DAUGHTER, INJURED IN A DRONE ATTACK IN THE BELGOROD REGION

On 4 July, Ukrainian UAVs struck two civilian vehicles on the section of the Borisovka-Baitsury highway near the junction with the Belgorod-Grayvoron-Kazinka highway. As the result of the explosion, two men, a woman and a 12-year-old child were injured.

The girl received a closed brain injury of medium severity, her mother – a barotrauma. One of the men got a penetrating wound to the eye socket, the other – multiple shrapnel wounds to his head, neck, right side of his chest, as well as second to third-degree burns.

Luckily, neither of the cars exploded that time. The people survived.



SETTLEMENT OF NOVAYA MAYACHKA: THE YOUNGEST VICTIM OF AFU UAVs

On July 6, in the early morning, the AFU attacked a civilian van with an FPV drone at the central market in the village of Novaya Mayachka in the Alyoshki City District of the Kherson Region. A woman and two men were wounded. The injured were hospitalized, two of them — in severe condition.

On July 9, the UAVs of the Ukrainian butchers returned. This time, a woman, born in 1986, and her two-year-old baby were injured in the village. They were taken to the Skadovsky Hospital.



YOUNG HUSBAND AND WIFE KILLED BY AN FPV DRONE IN BELGOROD REGION, TWO SMALL CHILDREN ORPHANED

On July 17, near the farm Tserkovny, the operator of a Ukrainian FPV drone killed a young married couple by attacking their family car.

Ksenia, born in 1994, and Vitaly, born in 1990, employees of the Agro-Belogorye group of companies, died in the fire before the ambulance arrived. The wife had recently returned to work after her second maternity leave. Their two small children were orphaned.

The Shumilov family were food industry workers, had the most peaceful of jobs. They enjoyed well-deserved respect of their colleagues. Vitaly, an electrician at the Belgorod pig farm, was to be decorated with the medal "For Labor Valor" for his hard work, including under AFU shelling, on the anniversary of the company. Due to his death at the hands of an AFU drone operator, Vitaly was awarded posthumously.

The memory of the young family killed in the AFU UAV attack was honored with a requiem mass in the village church of Nizhny Olshanets, which is being built on donations from the company. Before the service began, Metropolitan Ioann of Belgorod and Stary Oskol commemorated all the innocently murdered employees of Agro-Belogorye. There are 11 of them. Nine were killed in drone attacks on company buses in early May. Another 41 civilians were injured that day.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT HIT TWICE IN ONE DAY

Ukrainian UAV operators are massively targeting civilians. Alas, we are not speaking about isolated cases of severe mental disorders. It is clear that systematic flagrant violations of international humanitarian law are being encouraged from the very top.

On July 8, a drone attacked a tram on its route in the central city district of Gorlovka, DPR. The driver and a passenger – a woman born in 1957 and a man born in 1962 – were injured.

On the same day, a UAV attacked a passenger bus in the village of Voznesenovka, Belgorod Region. The driver was injured. With shrapnel wounds to his abdomen, face, arms and legs, the man was taken to the Shebekino Central District Hospital.




AFU UAV CARRIES OUT AN AIMED DROP OF AMMUNITION ON A PLAYGROUND, BELGOROD REGION: 4 CHILDREN WOUNDED, A TEENAGER DIES

On July 11, a Ukrainian UAV operator carried out an aimed drop of ammunition on a playground surrounded by multistorey residential buildings in the town of Shebekino, Belgorod Region. The ammo exploded near the football goals.

Five children were hospitalized with mine-blast traumas of varying severity.


The youngest of the injured children is 8 years old. He was taken by a mobile intensive care unit to the Russian Childrens' Clinical Hospital with a shrapnel wound to his spine. The boy had to undergo major surgery.

The eldest, a 16-year-old teenager, lost a lot of blood; shell fragments damaged vital blood vessels. Medics fought for his life for a week, but he could not be saved. Ivan, a promising young athlete, a prize-winner of the Belgorod Region Boxing Championship, died in the hospital on July 19.






MORE ATTACKS ON PASSENGER BUSES

On July 12, a 57-year-old man, was wounded when a Ukrainan drone dropped an explosive object on a bus N 41 in the Kirovsky district of Donetsk. The shuttle was on its route and had barely moved away from a bus stop when the ammunition exploded.

On July 18, in the Nikitovsky district of Gorlovka, DPR, a Ukrainian UAV attacked a passenger bus moving along Voznesenskogo Street. The bus driver, born in 1971, and three other civilians – two men born in 1990 and 1991, and a woman born in 1963 – were injured. One passenger was killed.

Such raids on public transport are carried out regularly, they differ only in the number of victims.






THREE INJURED IN AN AFU UAV ATTACK ON A CIVILIAN CAR IN THE BELGOROD REGION

On July 18, in the village of Otradnoye, Belgorod Region, a woman was driving her car when an AFU UAV attacked the vehicle. As the result, the car crashed into the fence of a private house and caught fire. It was a true miracle that the driver got away unhurt. She managed to jump out of the burning car.

However, three other civilians who happened to be nearby at the time of the attack were injured: a woman, a man and a 17-year-old teenager. The vehicle burned down completely.

Similar incidents occur on a daily basis.




UAV RAIDS ON TRAMS

On July 30 at 6.15 a.m., an operator of a Ukrainian drone attacked civilian transport once again. This time the target was a tram moving along Dmitrova Street in Gorlovka, DPR. The tram driver, a young man born in 1999, died on the spot of his wounds. The UAV was deliberately aimed at the roof of the vehicle directly above the driver. The cumulative jet passed all the way through the cabin and into the passenger compartment, injuring two women, born in 1957 and 1973.

The impact was so strong that a teenage girl, born in 2007, in a bus N 101 that was passing by was injured, too.

The day before, early in the morning, an AFU drone damaged another tram on the same street. Its 52-year-old female driver sustained injury.





UAV ATTACKS ON FARMING MACHINES

Grain harvesting has begun in the agrarian regions of Russia. Only during the first harvesting week, from July 15 to July 21, at least 15 farming machines were damaged by Ukrainian drones in the Belgorod and Kursk regions only.

On July 16, a UAV dropped an ammunition on a harvester working in the field in the village of Veseloye, Glushkovsky District of the Kursk Region. The driver, a man born in 1971, was taken to the Central District Hospital with multiple shrapnel wounds and a head injury. On the same day, two kamikaze drones carried out an attack close to the village of Obesta, Rylsk District of the Kursk Region. A tractor was damaged by shrapnel in the resulting explosion.

On July 17, near the village of Medvezhye, Glushkovsky District of the Kursk Region, a quadrocopter FPV drone struck a John Deere combine harvester belonging to the Pobeda LLC. The resulting fire burned 89 hectares of wheat. Another harvester was damaged in the neighboring Politotdelsky settlement. There was an attack by a kamikaze drone with subsequent detonation on the ground. 90 hectares of wheat caught fire.

On July 18, in the village of Yasnye Zori, Belgorod City District of the Belgorod Region, a Ukrainian drone dropped an explosive on a tractor working in the field, injuring its driver. On the same day, not far away from the previous site, another tractor driver was wounded as the result of the detonation of an explosive device dropped by a drone near the village of Cheremoshnoye. The workers who came to the rescue transported him to the Oktyabrskaya District Hospital, from where an ambulance team took the patient to the Belgorod City Hospital N 2. The man sustained multiple shrapnel injuries to the soft tissues of his head and an acubarotrauma.

On July 20 in the village of Snagost, Korenevsky district of the Kursk Region, two quadrocopter FPV drones attacked harvesters of the Agoroinvest JSC working in the field. As the result a mechanic, born in 1991, received shrapnel wounds of the left shin and left forearm. Two harvesters caught fire. The fire spread to the field. On the same day, a tractor was partially damaged in a kamikaze drone attack with its subsequent detonation on the ground in the vicinity of Novoivanovka, Sudja City District of the Kursk Region.

In the nearby Ivashkovsky settlement, an FPV drone raided a farm. A K-700 tractor was burned down. Two K-701 tractors were slashed by shrapnel.

In addition to the cases described above, AFU UAVs damaged and/or burned three more harvesters in the Belgorod Region during the week: in the village of

Malinovka, Belgorod City District; the farm of Mikhailovka, Valuysk District; and the village of Novoye, Volokonovsk District, on July 15, 17, and 20, respectively.

During the first harvesting week (from July 15 to July 21) in Belgorod and Kursk regions, the AFU damaged at least 8 harvesters and 7 tractors with their UAVs. Ukrainian drone operators injured three tractor drivers and a harvester driver.

On Monday, July 22, a tractor working in the field was once again attacked by a drone in the village of Ustinka, Belgorod City District. The driver Roman died on the spot of his wounds. His wife, who happened to accompany him that day, saw him die. The woman had a shrapnel wound to her right thigh.

According to the data confirmed as of August 1, in July AFU drone operators can boast at least 23 destroyed or damaged tractors and harvesters, as well as one killed and eight wounded – while working in grain fields – tractor and harvester drivers.



UAV ATTACKS AN AMBULANCE IN THE KURSK REGION

On August 7, the Sudja City District of the Kursk Region was subjected to a combined attack carried out by AFU militants using various artillery systems.

As a medical crew came to provide medical assistance to the wounded civilians, the ambulance was hit by a kamikaze-drone.

The paramedic and the driver died on the spot. The doctor was hospitalized with serious injuries.
